Short Description of Instrument	<p>The Pediatric Migraine Disability Assessment Questionnaire (PedMIDAS) is a 6-question form that is designed to assess migraine disability for pediatric and adolescent aged patients.</p> <p>This test is similar to the MIDAS and has been tested and verified for ages 4–18. A limitation of this instrument is that it requires recall over previous 3 months.</p>
Scoring	The score is a composite of the six questions with the lower scores indicating limited to no disability and the higher scores representing moderate to severe disability.
